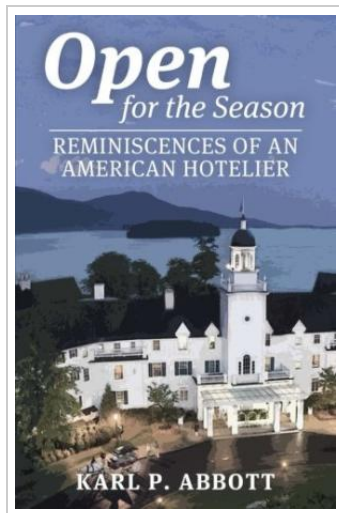




Open for the Season: Reminiscences of an American Hotelier (Paperback)
