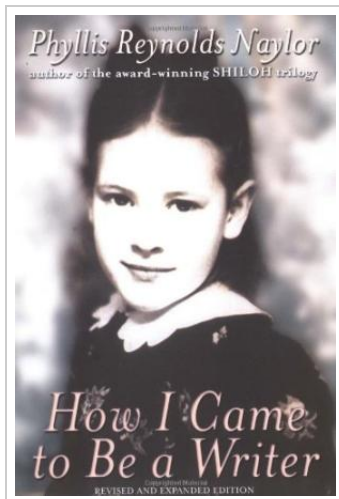




How I Came to Be a Writer
