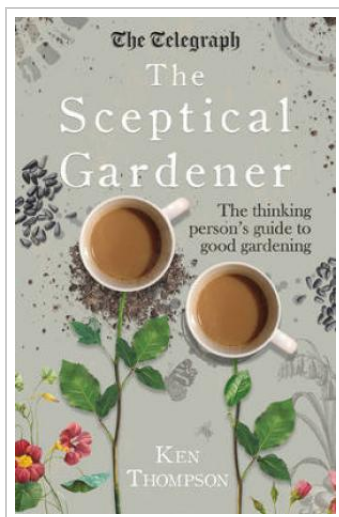




The Sceptical Gardener
