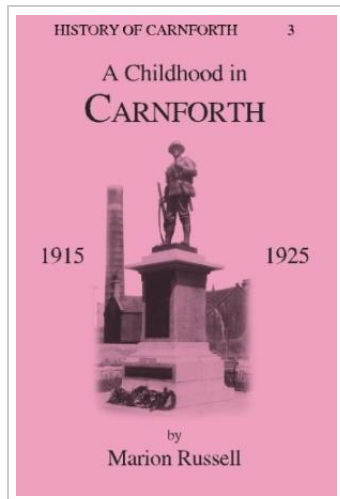




A Childhood in Carnforth (Paperback)
