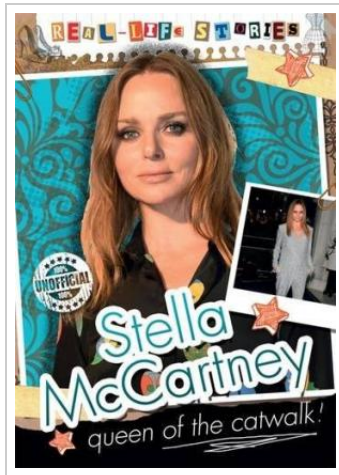




Real-life Stories: Stella McCartney (Hardback)
