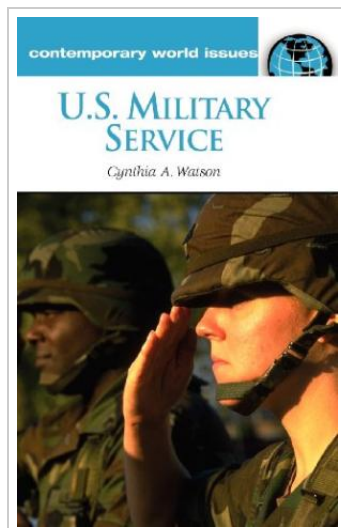




U.S. Military Service: A Reference Handbook (Hardback)
