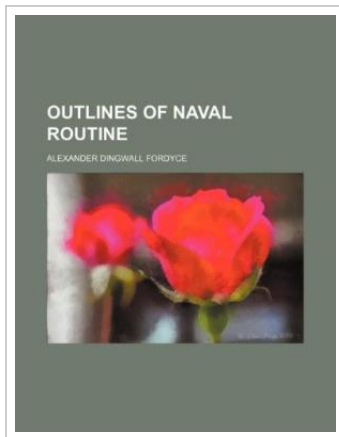

Have a Runner Tackle ready and stretched, along with a Lashing Block, to assist in purchasing the Anchor, if necessary. Reserve new and dry Nippers for the moment of being up and down, and have Sand ready to aid in making them bite. Bring to--If there be much wind or sea, this must probably be done with a Racking Nipper, and perhaps Racking Nippers must be continued till the first one reaches the after-part of the Main Hatchway; care being also taken not to unbit or unstopper...



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
