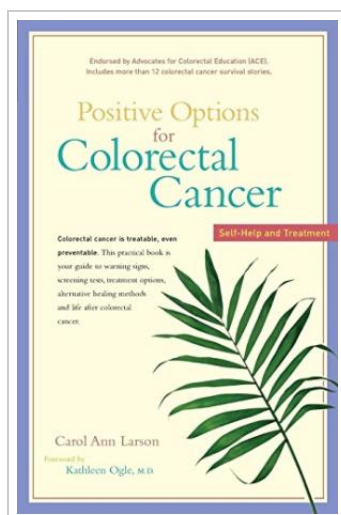




Positive Options for Colorectal Cancer: Self-Help and Treatment
