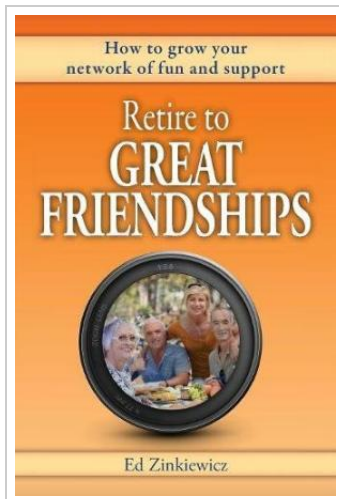




Retire to Great Friendships: How to Grow Your Network of Fun and Support
