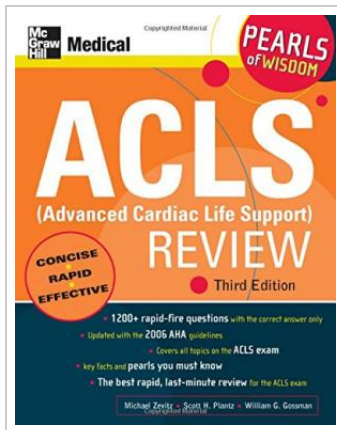




ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) Review, Third Edition (Pearls of Wisdom)
