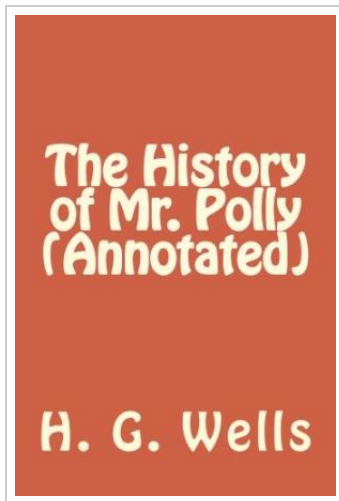




The History of Mr. Polly (Annotated) (Paperback)
