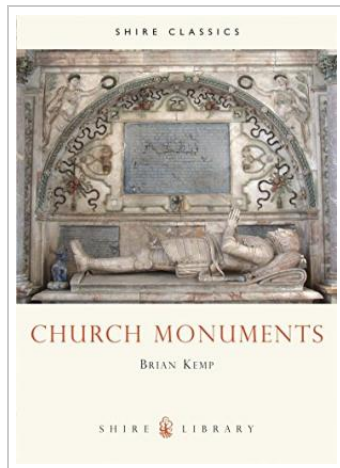




Church Monuments (Paperback)
