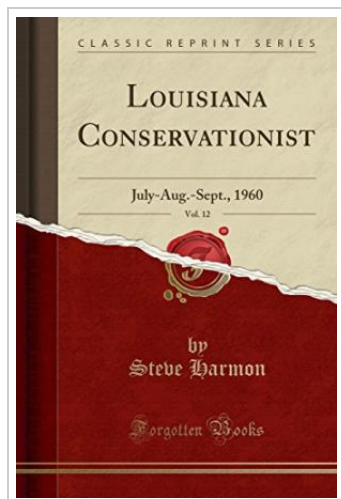

This provides protective cover for small fish, and serves as a windbreak for the levee. Two additional strips of trees were left standing across the lake for the same reasons.
