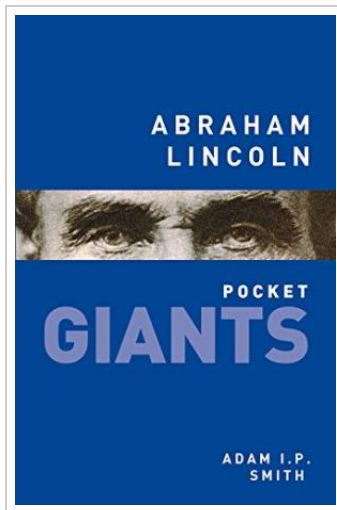




Abraham Lincoln: pocket GIANTS (Paperback)
