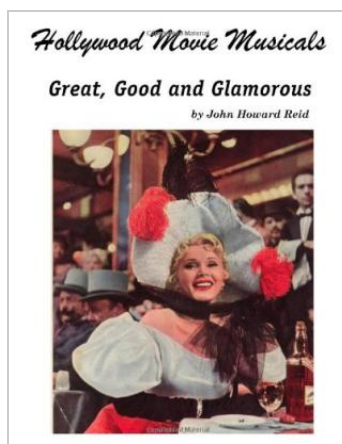




Hollywood Movie Musicals
