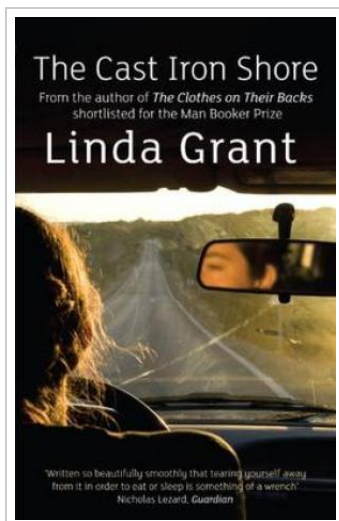




The Cast Iron Shore (Paperback)
