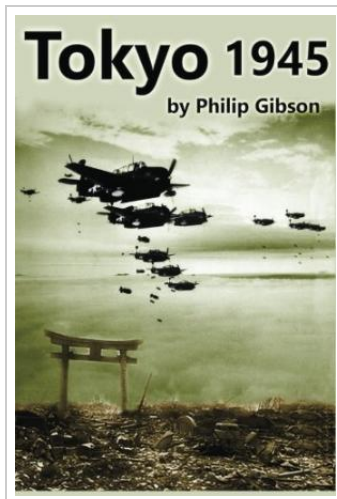




Tokyo45 The Final Days of World War II Hashtag Histories
