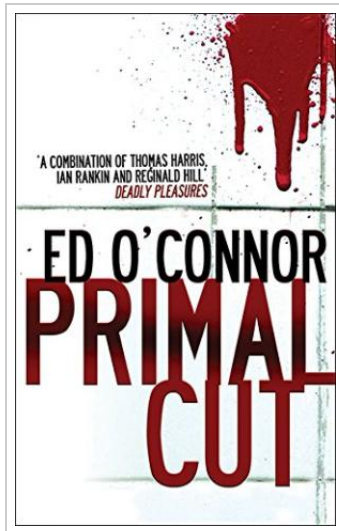




Primal Cut
