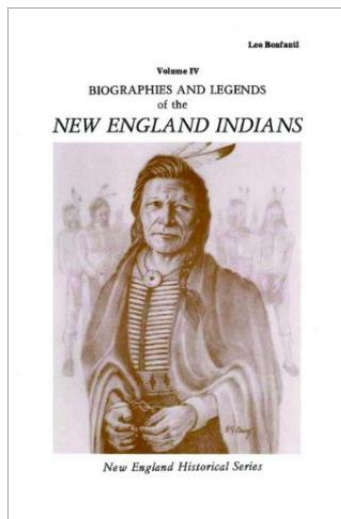




Biographies and Legends of the New Engla (Paperback)
