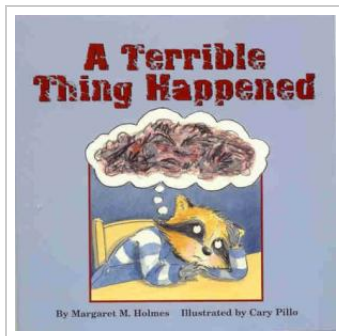




A Terrible Thing Happened (Paperback)
