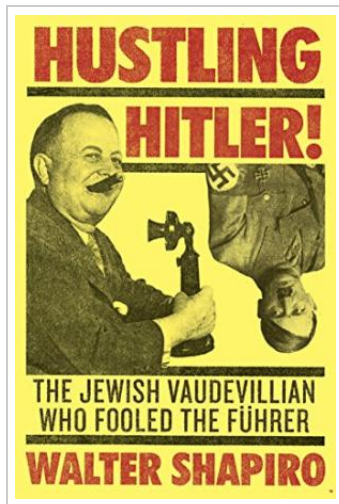




Hustling Hitler
