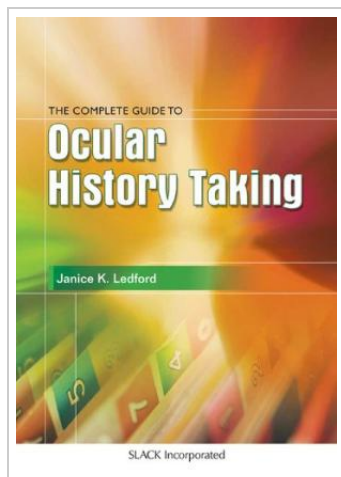




Ophthalmic History Primer
