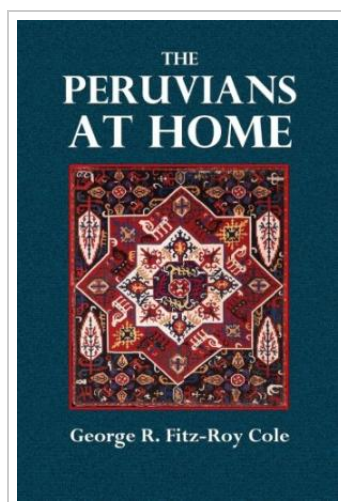




The Peruvians at Home
