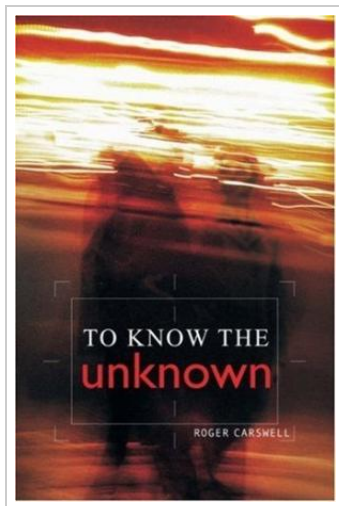




To Know the Unknown
