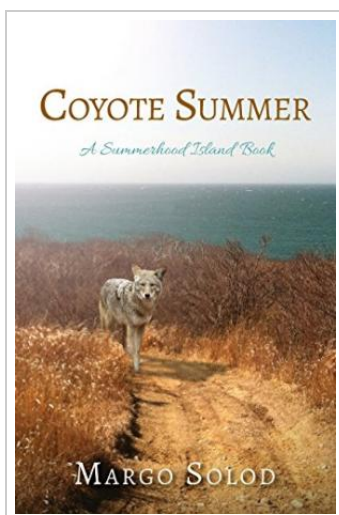




Coyote Summer A Summerhood Island Book
