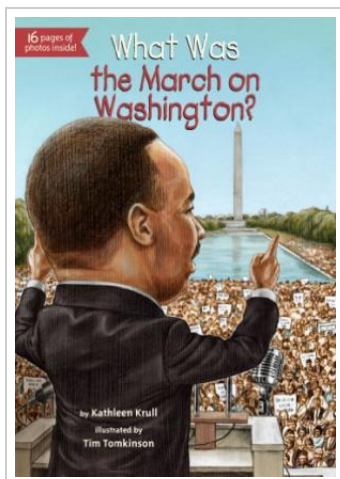




What Was the March on Washington?
