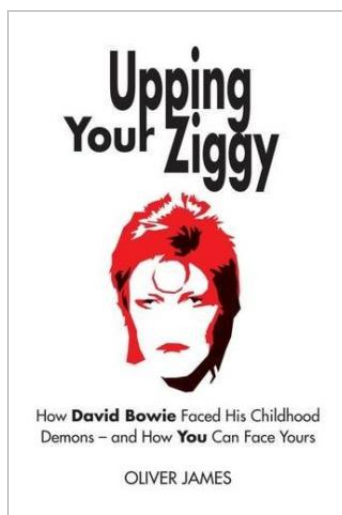




Upping Your Ziggy: How David Bowie Faced His Childhood Demons - and How You Can Face Yours (Paperback)
