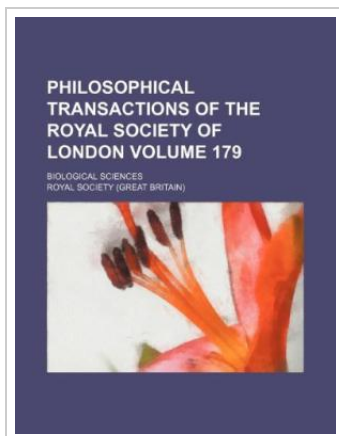

Not illustrated. 1889 Excerpt: .after fixation the larval mouth has flattened considerably, and presents the very peculiar appearance represented in fig. 26, which should be compared with the section through the same region in a free-swimming larva (fig. 24). The central part, which stains but slightly, no longer shows any cell-outlines, but is traversed by a fine network of threads, and contains a few extremely minute cells, whose nuclei stain intensely, and which may very possibly be phagocytes; while at each side of the groove there lies a deeply-stained mass, containing a few large but inconspicuous nuclei and an enormous number of small deeply-stained nuclei, which apparently belong to cells similar to, but perhaps usually larger than, the phagocytes (?) in the centre. Similar cells have already attacked the ciliated bands in fig. 20. Some hours later a transverse section through the larval mouth presents the appearance shown in fig....



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
