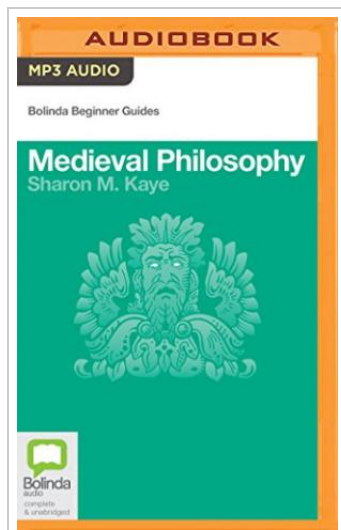




Medieval Philosophy
