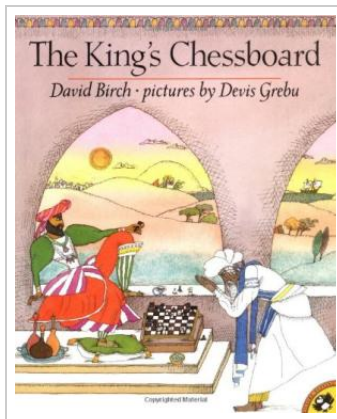




The King's Chessboard (Paperback)
