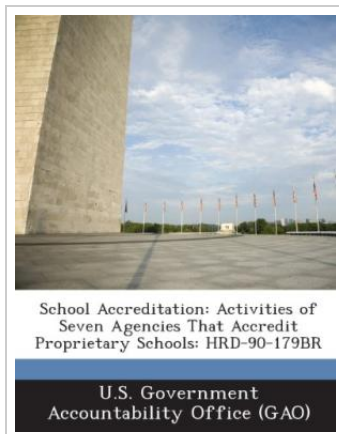




School Accreditation: Activities of Seven Agencies That Accredit Proprietary Schools: Hrd-90-179br

Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO reviewed information on the activities of seven agencies that accredited for-profit or proprietary schools that may participate in the Department of Education's Stafford Student Loan Program. GAO found that, between fiscal years 1985 and 1989: (1) the 7 agencies accredited 1,880 schools and denied 281 accreditation applications; (2) 6 agencies deferred accreditation of 437 schools and accredited or rejected those schools after a second review; (3) the National Accrediting Commission of Cosmetology Arts and Sciences (NACCAS) and the National Association of Trade and Technical Schools (NATTS) reaccredited the largest number of schools; (4) the 7 agencies terminated the accreditation of 315 proprietary schools; (5) NACCAS accounted for over 30 percent of schools with terminated accreditation; (6) over 200 schools accredited by NACCAS and NATTS did not reapply for accreditation once it expired; (7) the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education and Training accredited 65 branch campuses without site visits, but in May 1990 began conducting on-site visits to branch campuses as a condition of accreditation; (8) the Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools, the National...



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
