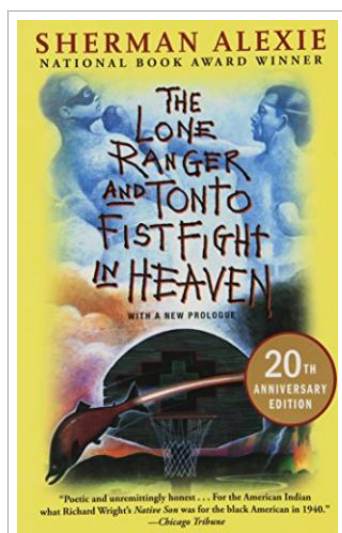




The Lone Ranger and Tonto Fistfight in Heaven (20th)
