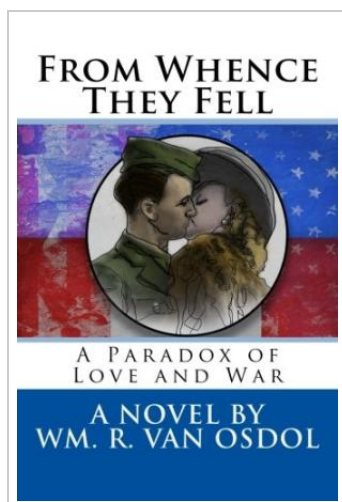




From Whence They Fell: A Paradox of Love and War (Paperback)
