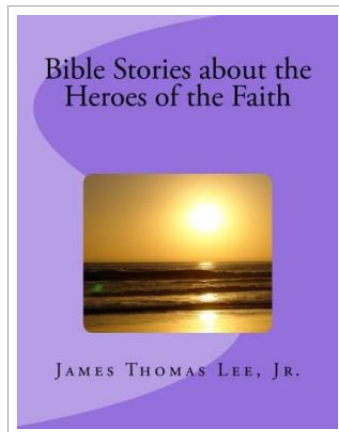




Bible Stories about the Heroes of the Faith
