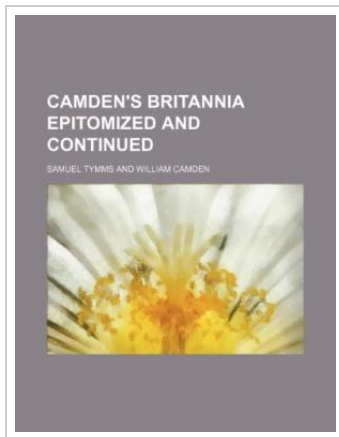

At Hexham, March 9, a large concourse of people assembled to oppose the ballot for the militia, when Ensign Hart, and a private of the North York militia, being killed, the Magistrates ordered the soldiery to fire, when 45 of the rioters were slain, and 300 wounded. 1771. September 7, the Tyne rose six feet higher than had been known for some years, and inundated Newcastle and the whole of its banks, doing a good deal of injury.
