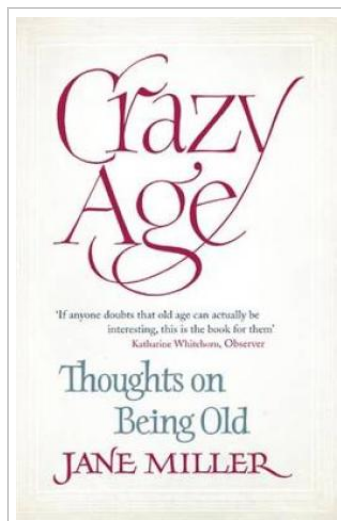




Crazy Age: Thoughts on Being Old (Paperback)
