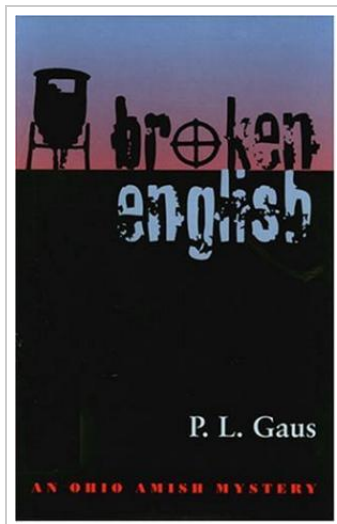




Broken English: An Ohio Amish Mystery
