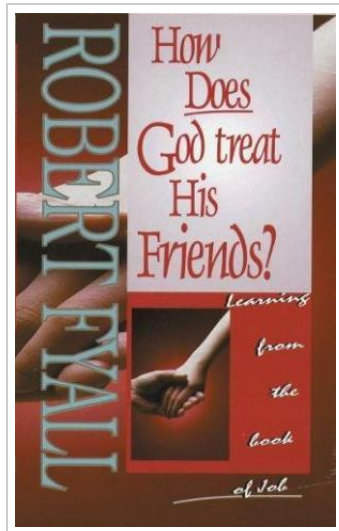




How Does God Treat His Friends?: Learning from the Book of Job (Paperback)
