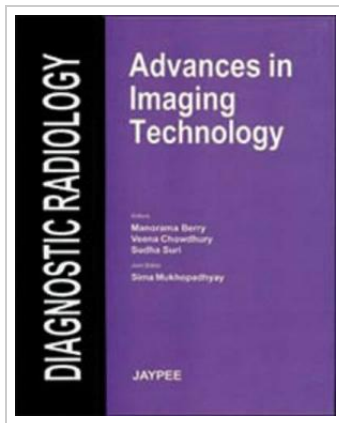




Diagnostic Radiology: Advances in Imaging Technology
