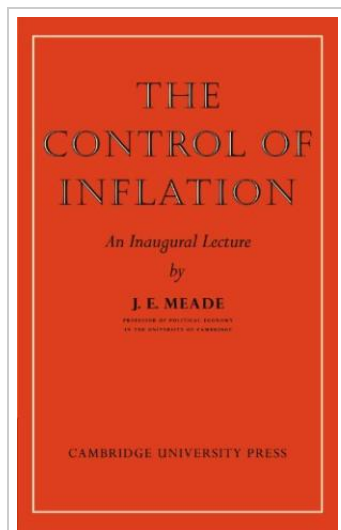




The Control of Inflation
