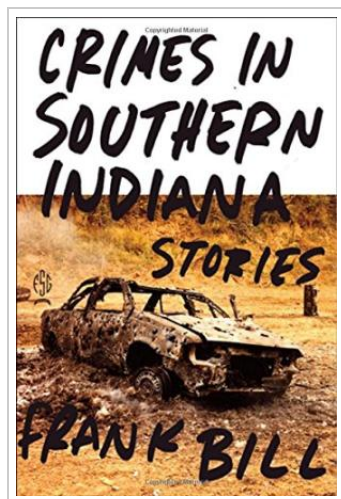




Crimes in Southern Indiana: Stories (Paperback)
