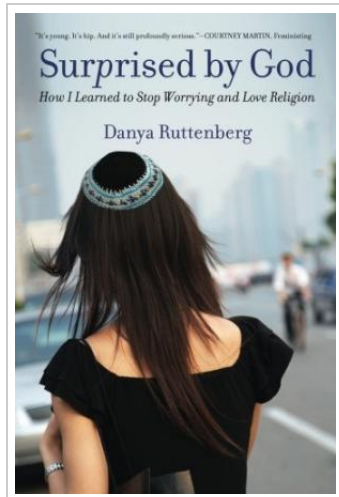




Surprised by God: How I Learned to Stop Worrying and Love Religion (Paperback)
