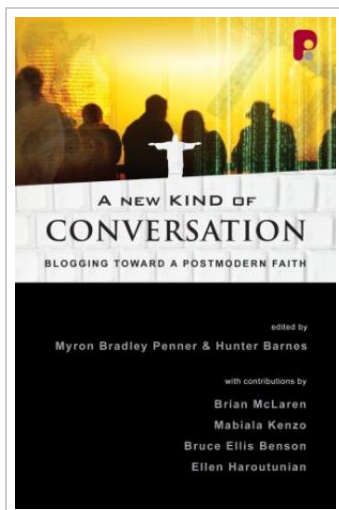




A New Kind of Conversation: Blogging Toward a Postmodern Faith (Paperback)
