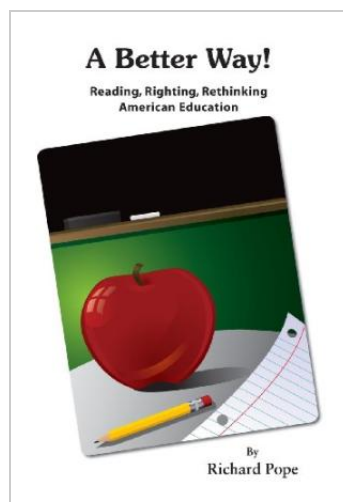




A Better Way - Reading, Righting, Rethinking American Education
