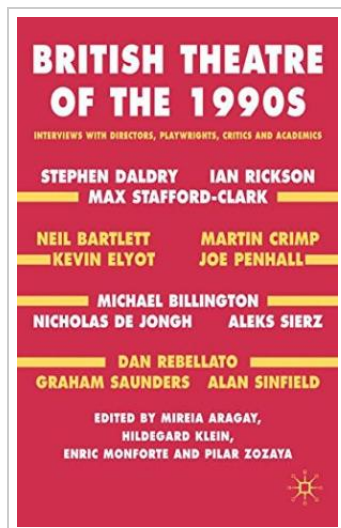




British Theatre of the 1990s: Interviews with Directors, Playwrights, Critics and Academics
