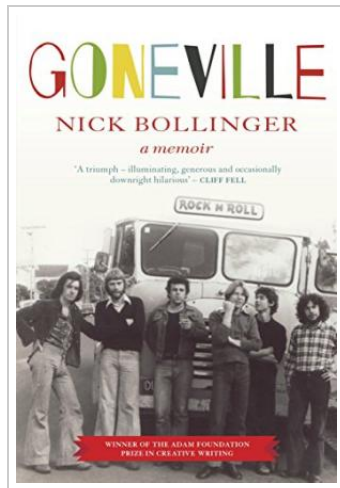




Goneville: A Memoir (Hardback)
