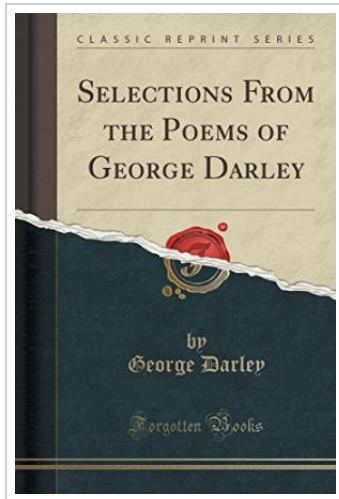




Selections from the Poems of George Darley (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)
