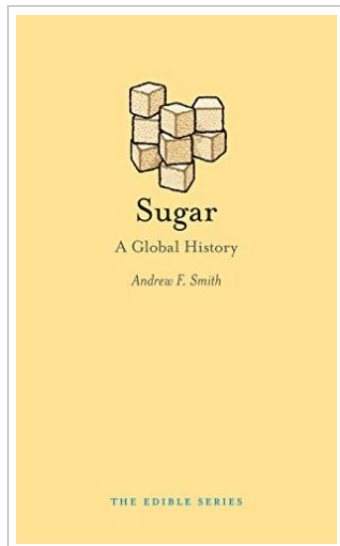




Sugar: A Global History (Hardback)
