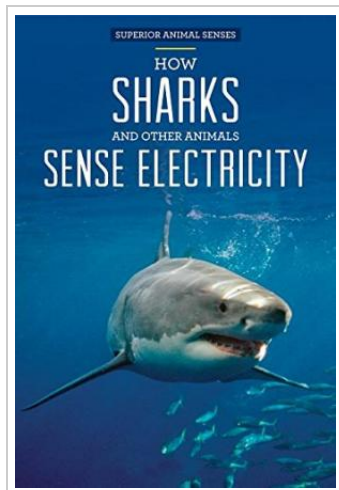




How Sharks and Other Animals Sense Electricity (Hardback)
