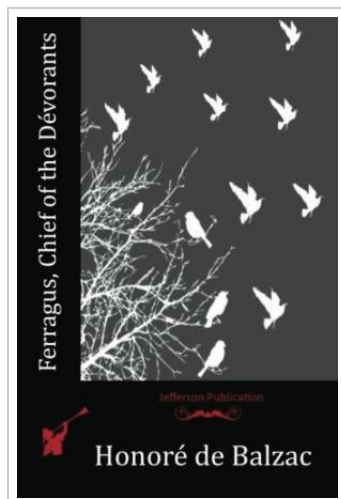




Ferragus, Chief of the Devorants (Paperback)
